

XML to JSON –Readme

Bot Overview

This bot performs the following:

- Converts XML to JSON .
- This is Useful to pass XML to Web services i.e. REST or SOAP.
- Sometimes we receive a XML as Input , we need to convert into raw JSON String Ourselves.
- This is a simple and reusable bot to generate a JSON File using XML File.

Prerequisites

- Automation Anywhere Enterprise v10.7 & above

Installation

- Download the bot from Bot Store.
- Double click on the .msi file.
- On Welcome to Installation wizard, click Next to continue.
- Click I agree to the terms in the license agreement radio button to accept the agreement.
- Get/Copy the License key from Bot Store Downloads into License Key, click Next to continue.
- Click Install to begin the installation.
- Click Finish to complete the installation.
- To view the installation, go to 'My Tasks' folder on AAE Client to see bot files.

Uninstall

- Open Add/Remove Programs -> Select the Bot/Digital Worker to be installed
- Click uninstall

Creates the following folder structure of the content in the AA Dir:

How to Use the Bot:

Use the following information to configure your bot:

Parameter Name	Type	Direction	Additional Info
vinputXMLFilePath	String	Input	Specify the XML Source file Path to Convert XML to JSON E.g. C:\User\Desktop\Test.XML
vinputXMLFilePath	String	Input	Specify the Output file Folder to keep the generated Word Document. E.g. C:\User\OutPut

Error Handling

- Each Bot folder contains the below hierarchy.
 - o Error Folder
 - Logs
 - Error Logs Month-Day-Year.txt: In case of any error, this file logs error message along with time stamp
 - Snapshots
 - Error Snap Month-Day-Year.png: In case of any error, this file captures screenshot of error.
- Task Status of bot is set to failed in case of errors.
