1. Introduction

This document contains all essential information for users to make full use of the Bing Translate Bot. This manual includes a description of the functions and capabilities as well as step-by-step procedures for the setup & configuration of the Bot.

1.1 Overview

The Bing Translate bot is meant to be used as a reusable utility component to enable language translation in 64 languages to be used in any number of custom bots that users create. It simply takes in the input of the text needed to be translated as well as the target translation language. The bot will then output the text translated to the target language.

Example:

InputText: 本文檔相當不錯。

OutputLanguage: English

OutputText: This document is pretty good.

2. Requirements & Prerequisites

2.1 System Requirements

Windows 64-bit and 32-bit versions are supported. No specific hardware requirements outside of those requirements needed for the installation of the Automation Anywhere enterprise client as well as Automation Anywhere 11.x and above.

2.2 Prerequisites

The bot only uses Automation Anywhere enterprise/community client and Internet Explorer.


