1.1 Overview

This Bot will Extract the Data Table from world population Web Browser and reply required detail of the country to the corresponding received email.

Use cases

The key use cases for this bot include:

- Bot will extract the web data table from https://worldpopulationreview.com/ Through screen scrapping.
- 2. Write the Extracted data to the CSV.
- 3. Connect to the Email and send read the unread recent email from inbox. Get the Country name client asked for details. Here I used Dictionary variable with key value.
- 4. After my Bot will read the corresponding country details from the extracted CSV.
- 5. After this my Bot will send all the required details to the respected Email.
- 6. In the sent mail the extracted CSV file also will be attached.
- 7. For sending mail in table format, I used HTML coding.
- 8. At last my Bot will show the pop up message I;e: Mail sent to recipient.

By default, the bot is set up to use Outlook to send the message via the context of the machine the bot is currently running on.

The best approach would be to specify email server details to be sure the bot emails could come from a consistent address regardless of which bot runner was executing the tasks.
