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1. Introduction

This document contains all essential information for the user to make full use of this A2019 Trello Package. It includes a description of the functions and capabilities and step-by-step procedures for setup & configuration.

1.1 Overview

This package enables integration of A2019 RPA Bots with Trello API features and functionality. The package provides actions to authenticate with the Trello server, and perform several actions leveraging the Trello API capabilities, such as creating teams, boards, lists or cards, managing members, and adding comments or attachments to cards.

A typical use of this package would involve creating a bot to automatically create a new team, adding a board to that team and creating introductory cards to guide the team on how to use the board.

1.2 Use cases

The key use cases include:

- Automate creation of team collaboration tools in Trello
- Administer teams/boards/members
- Automate comments, file uploads and new card creation

2. Requirements & Prerequisites

2.1 System Requirements

Review the machine hardware specifications, operating system versions, and browser types supported by Automation Anywhere Enterprise for creating and running bots and command packages as an Enterprise A2019 (Cloud deployed) or Community Edition user on your local machine.

2.2 Prerequisites

To get started with the Trello package, the bot creator will need to have a Trello account, and will need to retrieve their API key and token, following the instructions at this website:
