1. Introduction

This document contains all essential information for the user to make full use of this A2019 <u>PDF_Split_Operation</u>. It includes a description of the functions and capabilities and step-bystep procedures for setup & configuration of the <u>PDF_Split_Operation</u>

1.1 Overview

This Automation bot will take an input from the user via configuration file and read the pdf documents. After that Bot will read the split instruction from the configuration file which has been passed by user, based on that automation will split the document.

After splitting the pdf documents automation will create 2 folders under the output path which is supplied by user. 1^{st} is current date folder and 2^{nd} is PDF file name folder.

Under that PDF file name folder automation will save all the split pdf files.

- → Sample Input: D:\My Desktop\PDFOps\Filename.pdf
- → Sample Output: D:\My Desktop\PDFOps\DD_MM_YYYY\Filename\Filename_1.pdf

1.2 Use cases

The key use cases include:

- 1: If user have a pdf file with multiple pages but he/she want to work with some of the pages then this automation will help to split that pdf as per user's requirement.
- 2: If large export company receives a pdf document with large number of pages, but company wants only required number of pages to work with then also this automation will satisfy the company's requirement.

2. Requirements & Prerequisites

2.1 System Requirements

Enterprise A2019 (Cloud deployed) and Community Edition device requirements.

Review the machine hardware specifications, operating system versions, and browser types supported by Automation Anywhere Enterprise for creating and running bots and command packages as an Enterprise A2019 (Cloud deployed) or Community Edition user on your local machine.

User should have a **A2019** installed to take a benefit of this automation.

- Download the Bot from the Bot-store.
- Check the downloaded bot in your local machine private section.
- Once Bot is downloaded you are good to go for a run.
