This Automation bot will take an input from the user via configuration file and read the pdf documents. After that Bot will read the Merge instruction from the configuration file which has been passed by user, based on that automation will Merge the document.

After Merging the document, the automation will rename that Merged file with **Output.pdf** as universal name.

User can rename it after the successful run as per his/her convenience.

→ Sample Input of PDF Documents: D:\My Desktop\PDFOps\Files.pdf

→ Sample Output: D:\My Desktop\PDFOps\Output.pdf

## 1.2 Use cases

The key use cases include:

1: If user receives multiple pages of the PDF document and he/she wants that multiple pages into one single file for ease of access then this automation will merge that all pages of the file into single document.

2: If large export company receives a pdf document with large number of separate pages for one single customer, and company wants to require creating one file for single customer to work with then this automation will really be helpful to do so.
