1. Introduction

This document contains all essential information for the user to make full use of this A2019 – IQ Bot – Custom Domain Creation. It includes a description of the functions and capabilities and step-by-step procedures for setup & configuration of the IQ Bot – Custom Domain Creation.

1.1 Overview:

This bot helps you to create the custom domain in any A2019 environment using just a CSV as an input.

1.2 Use cases:

A domain contains information about the language of the documents and the fields that the system extracts from the documents.

The Domains tab displays all available domains for use in the system and their associated languages. Besides out-of-box domains offered by IQ Bot, you can also create a custom domain and import it into IQ Bot.

This custom domain helps to classify docs better in different groups.

- 1.If any language which is not available in IQ Bot prebuilt domains.
- 2. If any fields to be extracted other than prebuilt domains (mortgage,bank docs, KYC).

Best Practices while preparing CSV:

- Aliases should be separated using comma unlike pipe symbol.
- Aliases should be unique and mentioned only once across the entire csv file.
- Empty rows should be removed from the csv.
- Type column should contain: FORM_FIELD (rather than FORM) and TABLE COLUMN FIELD values only.
- At least one alias is mandatory for every line of item. Like Invalid Invoice Reason should have at least one alias
- Aliases are case in-sensitive, hence all same upper- and lower-case words will be counted as one.

2. Requirements & Prerequisites

2.1 System Requirements

Enterprise A2019 (Cloud deployed) and Community Edition device requirements.

Review the machine hardware specifications, operating system versions, and browser types supported by Automation Anywhere Enterprise for creating and running bots and command packages as an Enterprise A2019 (Cloud deployed) or Community Edition user on your local machine.

2.2 Prerequisites

User should have a **A2019** & **IQ Bot** installed to take a benefit of this automation.

3.1 Quick Start

3.1.1 Configuration and Use

- Download the Bot from the Bot-store.
- Check the downloaded bot in your local machine private/Public section.
- Once Bot is downloaded you are good to go for a run.
