1.1 Overview

This Automation will log into official site of Bombay Stock Exchange and retrieve the top 30 companies that are listed top on an equity index (SENSEX) and after user's given path of the output, the automation will generate a csv file with current date.

1.2 Use cases

The key use cases include:

The **BSE** enables investors to trade in equities, currencies, debt instruments, derivatives, and mutual funds. The **BSE** also provides other important capital market trading services such as risk management, clearing, settlement, and investor education.

Listing on the **BSE** ensures greater visibility in comparison with listing on larger foreign stock markets; ... Foreign investors have a strong presence on the Hungarian stock market, representing about 70-80% of the BSE's equity capitalization and its turnover.

What are the benefits of listing equities on the BSE?

Financing:

One of the primary advantages of listing on the BSE is the ease of financing by raising additional capital in the capital markets.

Liquidity:

In an international comparison, the BSE offers considerable market liquidity.

Media attention:

Listing on the BSE is accompanied by particularly significant attention from the local media, according to experience, in comparison with listing on other exchanges.

High ratio of foreign investors:

Foreign investors have a strong presence on the Hungarian stock market, representing about 70-80% of the BSE's equity capitalisation and its turnover. Foreigners can therefore trade shares on the BSE as easily as on any other large foreign market.

Heightened consumer awareness and confidence:

Presence on the BSE improves consumer awareness and confidence and improves company marketability and recognition.

Index membership and the associated additional demand for equity:

A company that might be considered mid-cap at best on a foreign market could be considered a leading equity on the BSE, and as such would likely be included in the BUX, the BSE's main equity index. This contrasts with listing on a foreign market, where the conditions for inclusion in a main index usually cannot be fulfilled. Considering that domestic institutional investors typically invest pooled funds into a portfolio with the same weighting as the BUX index, this undoubtedly creates additional demand for the shares of the company.
