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1. Introduction

This document contains all essential information for the user to make full use of this A2019 – Convert Excel to Json. This bot generates a json file from an excel file.

1.1 Overview

- Use of python script to convert excel data to json data.

1.2 Use cases

The key use cases include:

- Passes the input file path to python function.
- Converts the excel file to json file.
- Stores the json file in output folder with folder name as same as excel file. The folder contains sheet wise json file.
- Converted file is in .json format.

2. Requirements & Pre-requisites

2.1 System Requirements

1. Automation anywhere enterprise A2019 enterprise installed.
2. Python 3.8.x must be installed. [Install from here](#)
3. Mandatory Python Libraries to be installed ([How to Install a Package in Python](#)):
 - a. `pip install excel2json-3.`

3. Getting Started

3.1 Quick Start

3.1.1 Configuration and Use

The Bot provides following choices:

- 1) The bot creates input folder, log folder and output folder provided in the input variable table.
- 2) User can provide location of these folders in Config.xlsx.

The second condition requires little input from the User.

- Input Folder: Complete path of input folder. This folder should contain excel files that needed to be converted.
- Output Folder: Complete path of output folder.
- Log Folder: Complete path of log folder where ErrorLog.txt file is present.
