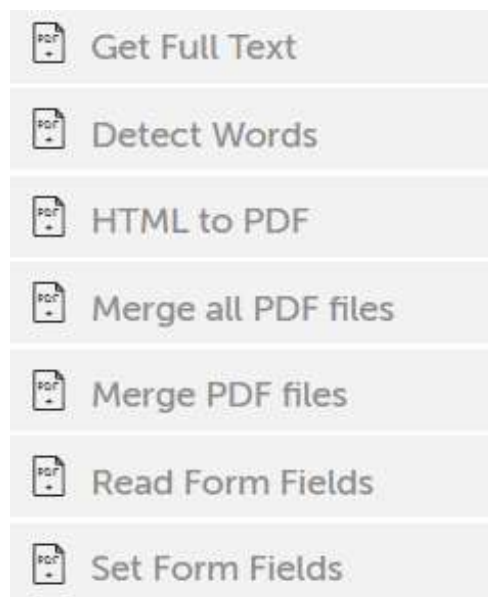
3.1 Quick Start

3.1.1 Setup

Import the Automation 360 PDF Utilities Package in the Control Room under Bots->Packages.

3.1.2 Configuration and Use

The package contains the following command and condition actions

| Get Full Text | Get text of a PDF document | Adobe File | Adobe PDF document |
| | | Password (optional) | Reader password |
| | | Text | Text of the document |
| Detect Words | Detect words and mark them in a document | PDF Input File | PDF document where to search for words |
| | | PDF Output File | PDF document which included marked words |
| | | List of words to detect | List of words to be detected |
| | | Match Case | True or false |
| | | Exact Match | Words can be substrings |
| | | RGB Color for markings | Red, Green and Blue color values for the text marking |
| | | Table of detected words | Table with words that have been detected in the PDF document. Table columns: "Word", "Page", "BoundingBox" |
| Read Form Fields | Reads the form fields of an Adobe Form or Adobe XFA document | Adobe Form File | Adobe PDF document |
| | | Password (optional) | Reader password |
| | | Form Fields | Dictionary of form fields |
| Set Form Fields | Set the values of the form fields in an Adobe Form or Adobe XFA document | Adobe Form File | Adobe PDF document |
