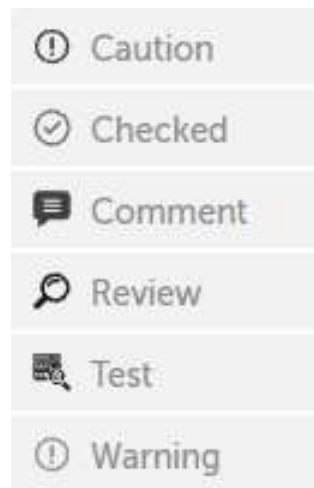
3.1 Quick Start

Test	Mark bot code with the "Test" marker	Comments	List of comments
Warning	Mark bot code with the "Warning" marker	Comments	List of comments
