1. Introduction

This document contains all essential information for the user to make full use of this A360 Bot. It includes a description of the functions and capabilities and step-by-step procedures for setup & configuration of the Bot.

1.1 Overview

The Bot will be used to convert various file types (.docx, .txt, .ppt, .pptx, .pptm) to PDF format. User needs to provide the folder path containing documents as input and run the bot. The bot will convert all the files with a .docx, .txt, .ppt/.pptx/.pptm extension to a PDF file format.

1.2 Use cases

The key use cases include:

- a. The user needs to install this library in Command Prompt window to execute the python script.
 - `pip install aspose.slides==22.10.0`
 - `pip install aspose-words==22.10.0`
 - `pip install aspose.slides`
- b. Check if the folder exists at "iStrFolderPath", if exist then check the files exist with extension docx,txt,ppt/pptx/pptm
- c. Writing Python Script to convert above mentioned file to pdf.
- d. By using Python package taking the input using execute script and save the output file at the same location.
- e. The file with (docx) extension will be converted to (pdf) extension.
- f. The file with (txt) extension will be converted to (pdf) extension.
- g. The file with (ppt/pptx/pptm) extension will be converted to (pdf) extension.
- h. The output result in "oBoolSuccessFlag" is set if script runs Successfully .

2. Requirements & Prerequisites

2.1 System Requirements

User should have a python version above 3.9.6 to below 3.11 installed to take a benefit of this automation.

3.1 Quick Start

3.1.1 Configuration and Use

- Download the Bot from the Bot-store.
- Check the downloaded bot in your local machine private/Public section.
- Once Bot is downloaded you are good to go for a run.
- Please change the OutputPath to your required path into the configuration file to generate the CSV file.
- By Default, it will generate the CSV file under iStrFolderPath.
