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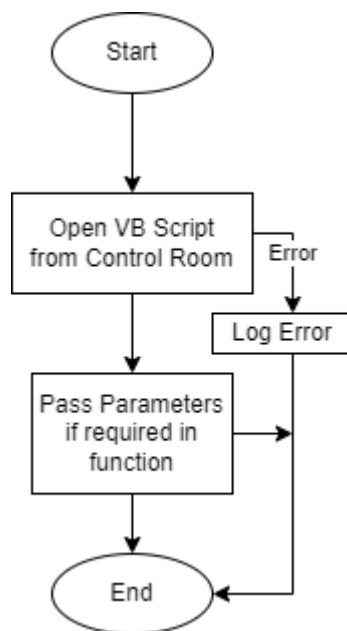
1. Introduction

2.1 System Requirements

2.2 Prerequisites

1. *User should have an A2019 installed to take benefit of this automation.*
2. *User should be using a VB Script– 2.16.0 package.*
3. User should use the same date format.
4. For the date format the notation used for day, month and year is d, M, y (e.g. MM/dd/yyyy)

3.1 Quick Start

3.1.1 Configuration and Use

1. Download the Bot from the Bot-store.
2. Check the downloaded bot in your local machine's private/Public section.
3. Once Bot is downloaded, you are ready for a run.
4. Takes two inputs and calculates date diff.
