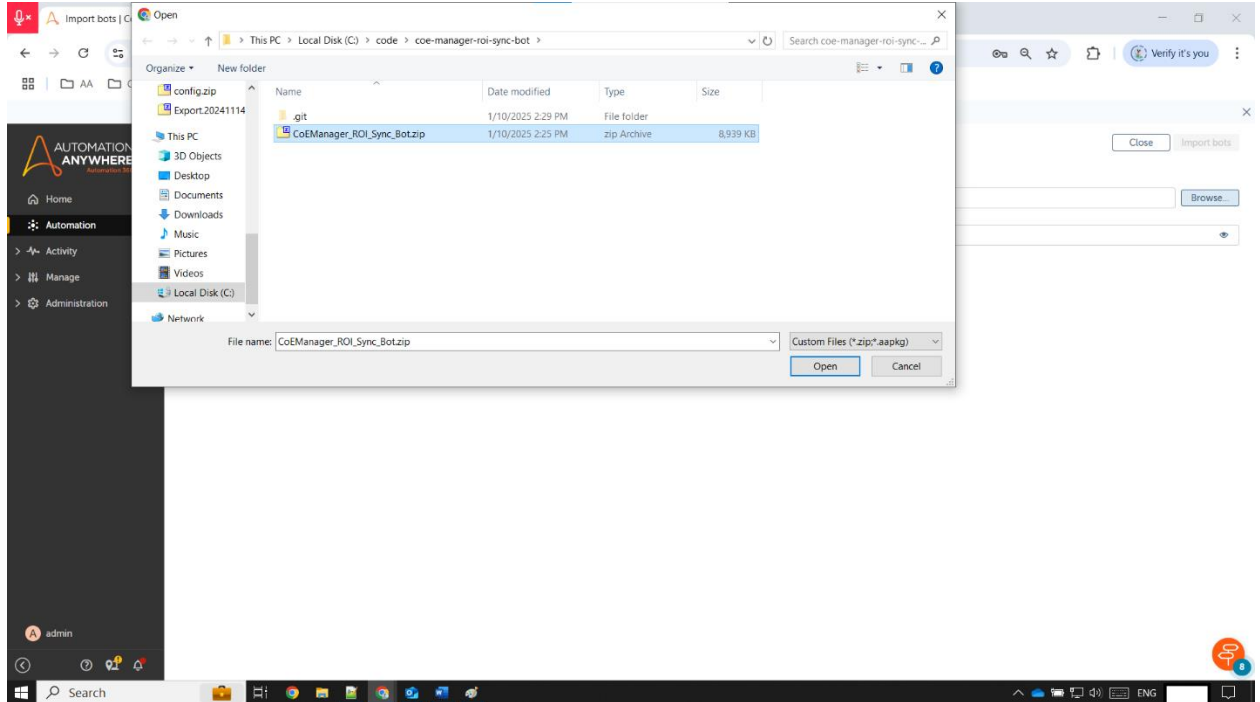


CoE Manager ROI Sync Bot

1. Import the bot in to AA360 Control Room

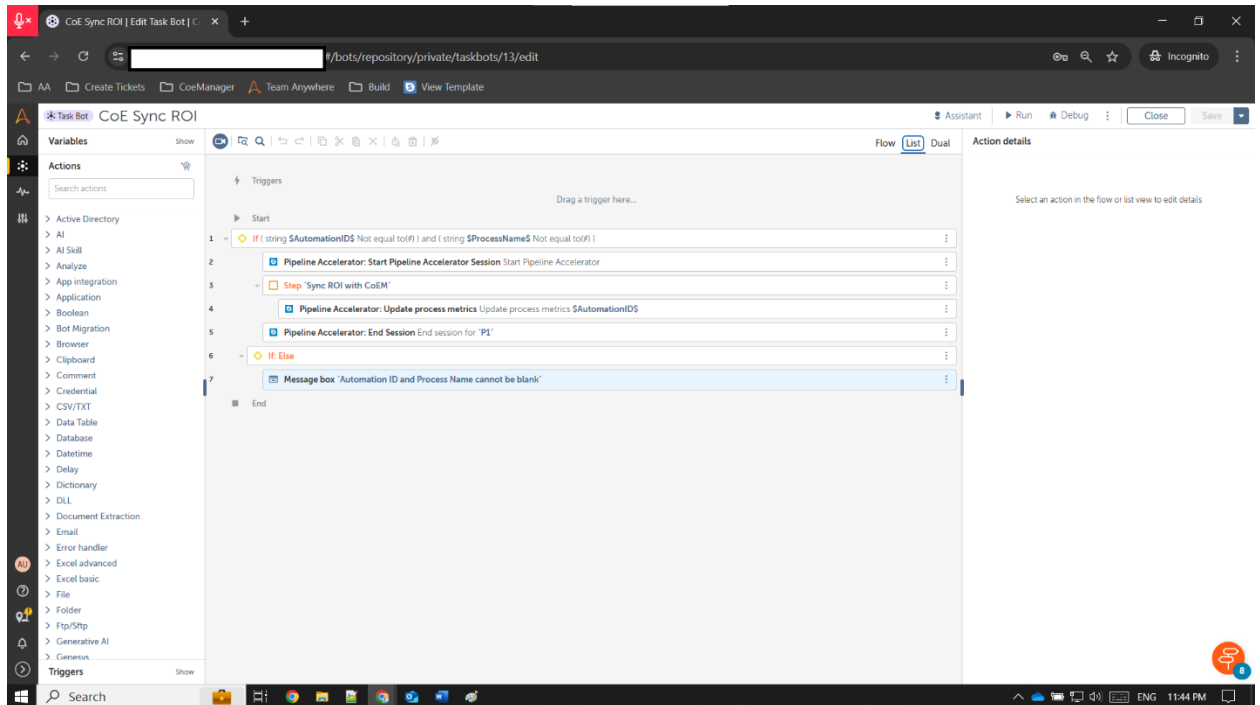

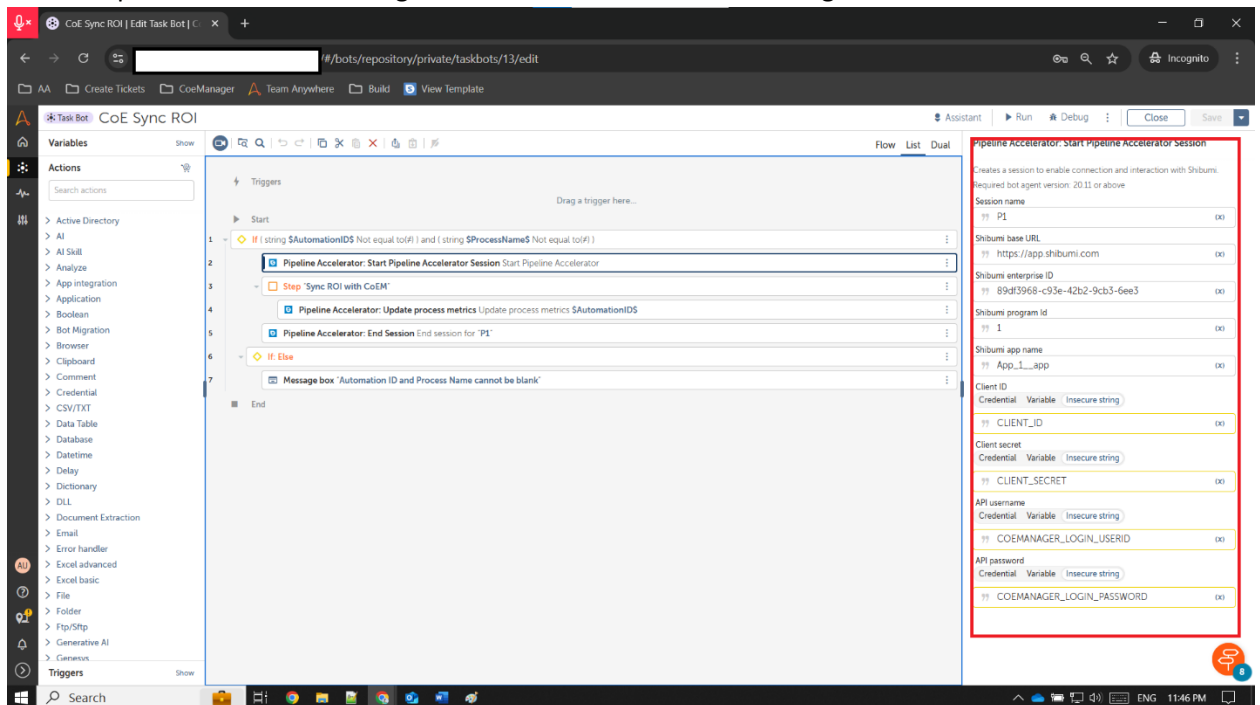

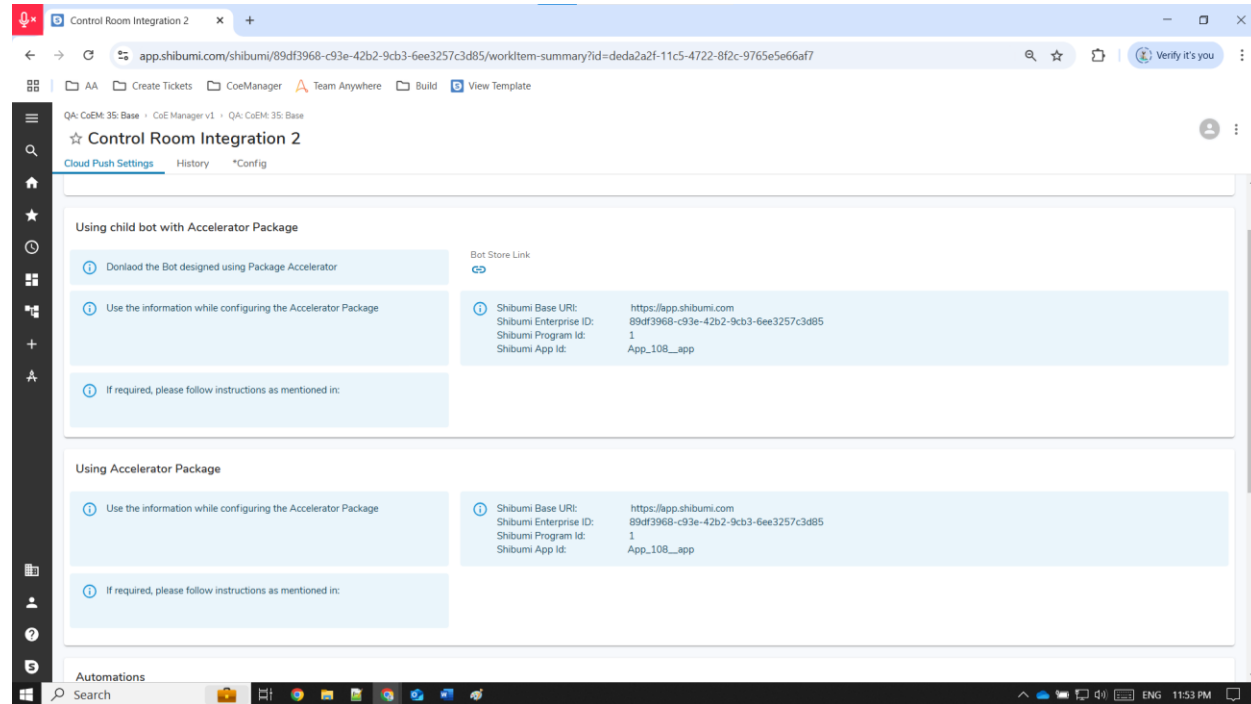


5. Go to Step 2 of the bot and configure it with the details of CoE Manager
